The show has kindly offered for anyone who wishes to stay overnight to coral ponies and for people to camp in tents/lorries. Corralling is at your own risk and you will need to provide fencing to contain your pony. We are unable to use the racecourse stabling due to Jockey Club restrictions. Exmoor Pony In Hand Classes

Open to ponies registered into section 1 of the Exmoor Pony Society Studbook

Handlers of colts or stallions must be at least 14 years old. Any handler under the age of 14 must wear a riding hat.

- 1. Yearling; colt, filly or gelding.
- 2. 2 & 3 year old; colt, filly or gelding.
- 3. Gelding; 4 years & over.
- 4. Stallion; 4 years & over.
- 5. Mare; 4 years & over.
- 6. Veteran 15 years & over
